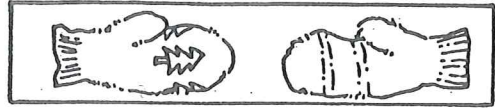
Outside play...

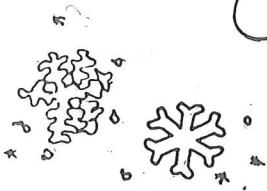
Make sure everything is labeled.
