



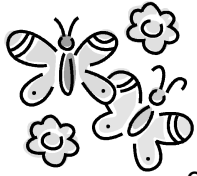

March as well.

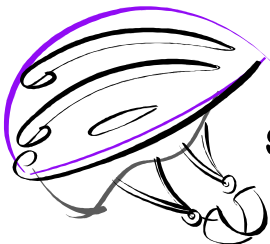
## Flower Bulb Sale

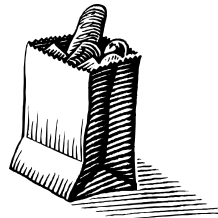

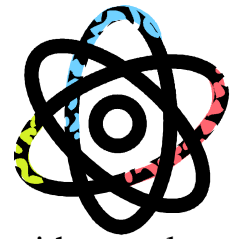
## PARENT TEACHER CONFERENCES

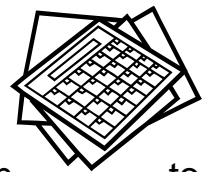
## Welcome to Trinity Nursery School!
